6. **Continuous improvement:** NAAC accreditation is not a one-time process but an ongoing one, which ensures that the institution is continuously striving for improvement in all aspects.

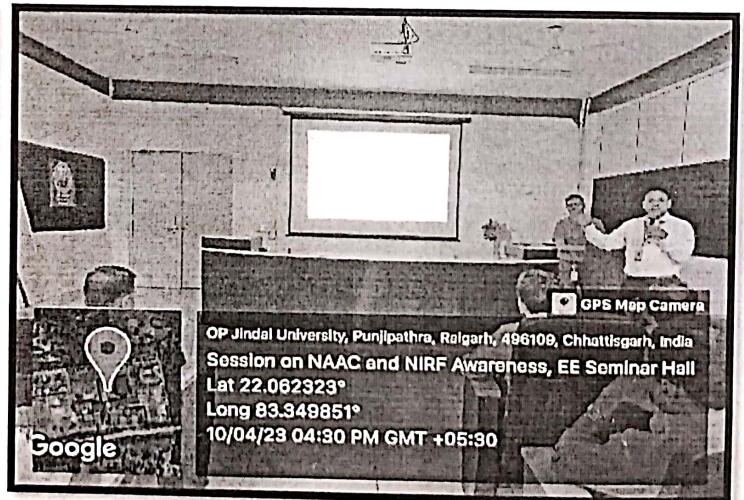
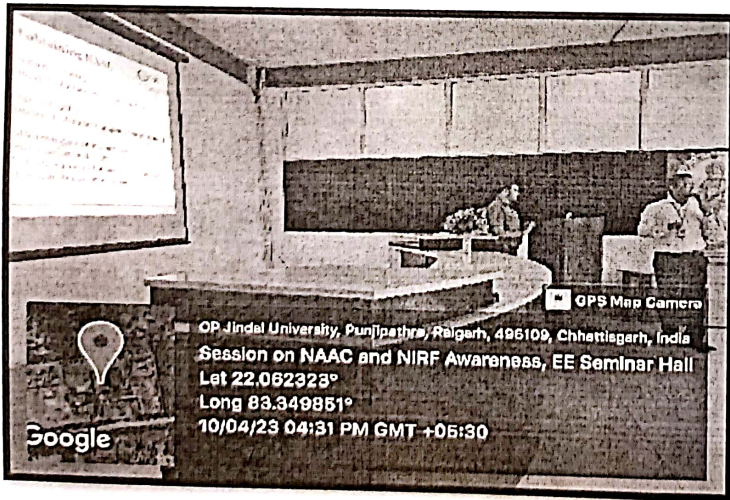
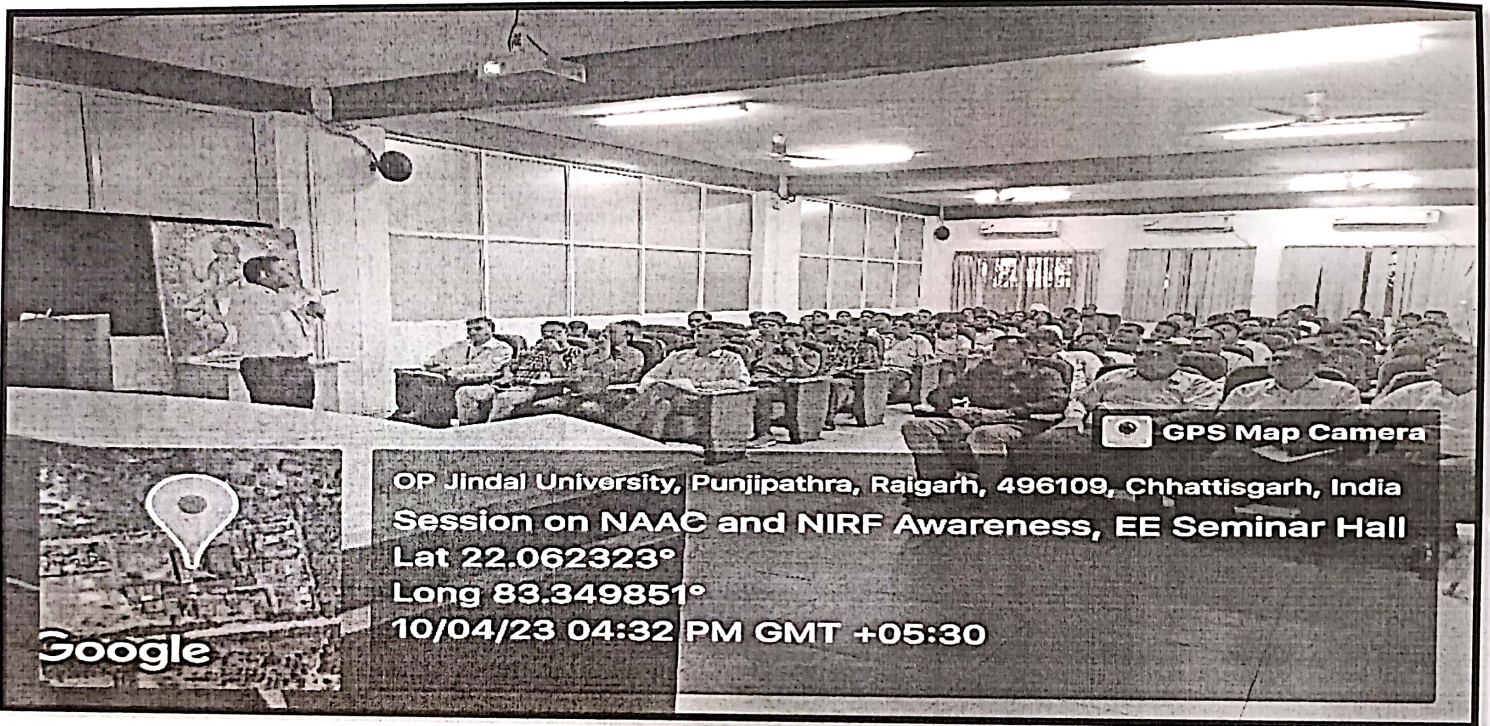
