


## The Agenda of the Meeting was:

The meeting started with a welcome address by Chairman Dr. R. D. Patidar followed by a presentation about IQAC, its existence and functions at OPJU. The Chairman also shared the activity snapshots conducted in the academic year 2020-21 along with proposed plan for the academic year 2022 with special emphasize on obtaining the NAAC A+ grade.

## The following points were discussed in the meeting.

1. Mr. Nilesh Shah (Representative of Employer), suggested to host industry related seminars by inviting the industries across the country and to start some student innovation clubs in the University. He also emphasized on upgrading the student's creativity, communication and behavioral skills and suggested the addition of Mechatronics' and Environmental Engineering courses in the curriculum in future. He suggested to make collaboration with companies like WIPRO, KOOKA etc to get some more industry exposure.





- Mr. Rajesh Singh, (Representative of Industry) suggested to improve the Communication and Leadership skills of students to remove the level of hesitation and fear while facing the job interview. He suggested to add robotics and AI based courses in the curriculum along with training of students in latest software which are in demand. He emphasized on formalizing the feedback collection of students placed and for those who are at Internships from the employer to fulfil the latest requirement of the industry.
- 3. Dr. B. K. Sthapak, (Member Nominated by the Governing Body) was concern about NAAC SSR status. He emphasized on improvement of teaching learning process and maximum student's participation for institutional building to get NAAC A+.
- Gagan Wasan (Representative of Alumni) highlighted that the quality of education can only be measured by a measuring the quality of pass out students. So to inculcate this quality he added that local problem should be kept in mind while introducing new courses like environmental engineering, transportation engineering etc. Alumni interaction should be increased to motivate the students. A positive environment should also be created among students to achieve the excellence in their endeavor.
- 5. Mr. R. P. Pandey suggested to incorporate the courses like renewable engineering, energy audit, solar energy, waste management.
- 6. Dr. S. S. Chakrabarti (HoD Mechanical Engineering) confirms that department of mechanical engineering has already introduced the mechatronics in 5th semester curriculum. He also added that we are in the process of revising our curriculum to give emphasis on automation and digital manufacturing.
- Dr. Shrikant Prasad (HoD Electrical Engineering) assured that from next year onwards we are going to start the courses on the area of renewable energy and energy management.
- 8. Dr. A. K. Shrivastava (HoD Metallurgy Engineering) appreciated the feedback of industry partners and added that we are in the process of improving our teaching learning and research innovation area to meet the industry needs and support NAAC preparation.

The meeting ended with formal vote of thanks by Director-IQAC, Dr. Ashok Bhansali and assured the IQAC committee that the university will put best effort to incorporate those suggestions.
