

Following proceedings were recorded in the meeting:

- 1. Dr. R. D. Patidar, Vice-Chancellor, OPJU welcomed the newly appointed Chancellor Ms. Shallu Jindalji on board of OPJU. He also welcomed all other members and introduced Ms. Shallu Jindal Ji, Chancellor, OPJU before all the members. With the permission of the chair, Dr. Patidar gave a presentation.
- 2. Dr. Patidar appraised all the members about the latest activities carried out in the University viz. awards & recognition, conferences & workshops organized, 1st convocation of the University, Scholarships, during & post-COVID operations of the university, etc.
- 3. He also presented the admission overview before the members with detailed analysis including programs admissions, quality of input, number of admissions from other states, etc.
- 4. The Vice-Chancellor also presented the development plan for the year 2021-22. A financial snapshot was also presented before the members.
- 6. All the members were apprised about the preparation of the NAAC. It was informed to the members that the University is intended to get a NAAC A+-Progress so far in this respect was also presented.
- 7. A policy for the students and families of employees who have suffered due to this unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic, were presented before the members. The Vice-Chancellor informed that so far, no employee is falling under this category, only 4 to 5 students lost the parents/ earning member due to COVID-19. As of today, the total impact will be approximately 2.5 Lac towards students. All the members unanimously approved the policy.
- 8. Approval to recruit teaching and non-teaching staff presented before the members. Dr. Patidar informed all the members that this year student strength has reached approximately 1700 and to maintain the quality education and research outcome it is very much essential to recruit quality faculty by maintaining the cadre ratio as per the need. The projections of the next three years towards faculty requirements were also presented before the members. In addition to teaching staff, the university also required some non-teaching staff including one Assistant Registrar, 2 Assistant Librarians, Asst. Manager in IT, CDC, Admin, and hostel, etc. All the members unanimously approved the same.





9. Hon'ble Chancellor appreciated the efforts made by the University towards achieving academic excellence. She suggested the Vice-Chancellor to explore the possibility and include the B. Tech program in Energy Technology in the OPJU curriculum.

The Chancellor also requested the board members to share their views and suggestions for the improvement of the University.

- Dr. Manju Salil Mitra has come forward to help and guide the university to obtain NAAC by the virtue of her experience. Hon'ble Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor appreciated her concern.
- ❖ Dr. R. N. Baghel appreciated the University's activities and congratulate all the faculty and staff of the University for their phenomenal performance in each area including research. Dr. Baghel also welcomed the generousness of the University by launching a policy for the students and families of employees who have suffered due to this unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic.
