

ABSATRACT OF MINUTES OF MEETING OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL OF THE UNIVERSITY HELD ON January 4,2019 IN UNIVERSITY CAMPUS AT 03:00 PM

Agenda of the meeting:

- 1. Approval of Admission policy/notification for the admission year 2019-20.
- 2. Approval of changes in syllabus of B. Tech (CSE & EEE) and M. Tech-CSE.
- 3. To review preparation of AICTE approval of B. Tech, M. Tech and MBA program.
- 4. Any other point with the permission of chair.

Following proceedings were recorded in the meeting:

- 1. The Member Secretary welcome all the members of the council. Minutes of last meeting were read and they were confirmed.
- 2. The Member Secretary presented admission policy for the year 2019-20. After thorough discussion it was decided that admission policy will remain same for B. Tech, M. Tech, BBA, MBA, B.Sc., M.Sc. and PhD programs. Further it was decided that admission policy for proposed Diploma Engineering program to be prepared as per the ordinance submitted for the Gazette notification and in-line with AICTE policy. However, admission notification will be issued for this program after the Gazette publication of the Ordinances.

It was further decided to start B. Tech- Electrical Engineering in place of B. Tech Electrical and Electronics Engineering and M. Tech- Structural Engineering w.e.f. Academic Year 2019-20. All these new programs will also be incorporated in the admission notification -2019.

Further intake of various courses was approved by the council and decided to send it BOM with the recommendation of approval.

- 3. The proposed changes in the syllabus of B. Tech (CSE & EEE) and M. Tech (CSE) were approved unanimously.
- 4. The Member Secretary informed the members about the preparation of AICTE approval of various courses of B. Tech, M. Tech and MBA. It was decided that







University shall apply for B. Tech (All course), M. Tech (All Specialization) and MBA programs to AICTE along with approval of FN, PIO, OCI, Gulf Quota students.
