

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Minutes of the Meeting held on 10th July, 2019 in the office of the Registrar at 01:00 PM as per the agenda points given below:

- 1. Review of regulations of three schools i.e. SoE, SoM and SoS of the University,
- 2. Change of relative grading to absolute grading,
- 3. Revaluation System.

The following proceedings were recorded during the course of the meeting:

- 1. Mr.Anurag Vijaywargiya, Registrar (I/C), welcomed all the members to discuss on the above mentioned agenda points and finalized the matter related to grading system of all the courses being taught in three Schools of the University and implementation of the same from the Academic session 2019 onwards.
- 2. Review of regulations of School of Engineering, School of Management and School of Science were made. It was unanimously decided & agreed to change the relative grading to absolute grading, to maintain uniformity of grading in all the three schools of the University as per the details given below:

Grade	Range of marks (Theory & Practical) [PRE+ESE]
A+	M≥ 90
A	80≤M<90
B+	70≤M<80
В	60≤M<70
C+	50≤M<60
С	40≤M<50
F	M<40

3. Further, it was decided to implement award of Class or Division as per the details given below and will come in to force from 1st Batch of OPJU onwards:

For B. Tech /M. Tech /Diploma (Engg.)/MBA

Distinction	8.00 ≤ SGPA/CGPA ≤10
First Division	7.00 ≤ SGPA/CGPA < 8.00
Second Division	$6.00 \le SGPA/CGPA < 7.00$
Pass Division	4.5 ≤ SGPA/CGPA < 6.00

For B.Sc., M.Sc. and BBA students will be as under:

Distinction	8.00 ≤ SGPA/CGPA ≤10		
First Division	6.5 ≤ SGPA/CGPA < 8.00		
Second Division	5.5 ≤ SGPA/CGPA < 6.5		
Pass Division	4.5 ≤ SGPA/CGPA < 5.5		

4. Percentage calculation for all the Schools will be as per the formula given below:

(SGPA or CGPA- 0.5)*10

- 5. It was also decided and agreed upon by the members present for deletion of Clause no.7.3 , read with sub-point no.1 and 2(Scheme of Examination for Theory Courses having two or less credits) as its interpretation creates a confusion and ambiguity. The above clause (7.3 read with point no.1 and 2) should be deleted with immediate effect from the existing regulations.
- 6. Weightage of Students' attendance on TA Marks: It was also unanimously agreed upon that Students' attendance will be linked up with TA marks for overall benefit of the students and this practice will come into force with immediate effect in all Schools.
- 7. Revaluation: It was, further, decided by the members present in the meeting that the system of revaluation will be implemented from the Academic Session 2019-20 for which a requisite fee per subject will be charged, and the guidelines will be finalized after discussion with V.C. Sir.
- 8. It was decided that the matter regarding other changes in regulations will be discussed with the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the University. On receipt of the consent and after getting his approval, further modifications will be executed in the regulations for finalization of the documentation.

There being no other points for the discussion, the meeting concluded with thanks to Chair.
