# NOTICE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR

Application for enrolling for 'Minor' qualification in a branch other B. Tech. Sub: Major (2022 Batch)

The University invites application from students admitted in the academic year 2022-23 in School of Engineering who are interested in 'Minor' qualification in a branch other than B. Tech. Major.

The University recognizes that some students may realize their passion for certain subjects after they have enrolled in the University. Students are permitted to pursue their interests in discipline other than their allotted branch by opting for a Minor qualification in another stream. This is a useful option for meritorious students to earn a 'Minor' qualification in addition to their B. Tech. Major. Some advantages of additional Minor qualification include:

- Gaining inter-disciplinary knowledge in areas of high growth and potential.
- Enhancing placement prospects
- · Better opportunity to pursue higher studies in an inter-disciplinary field of study.

The University allows Minor qualifications in:

- Computer Science & Engineering
- > Management
- ➤ Robotics & Automation

To complete a Minor qualification: -

- 1. Students will have to study minimum 5 subjects prescribed for the branch/discipline and earn minimum 20 credits during Semester III to VII/VIII. Of these subjects, at most 3 may be from the list of electives of that branch
- 2. Other Academic regulations, viz examination scheme, evaluation scheme, passing standard, grading system and attendance, will be the same as applicable to award of B. Tech degree.

The eligibility criteria, fee and application process for the Minor program will be as follows:

## 1. Eligibility:

- > Students should have an aggregate CGPA of 6.00 or more at the end of second
- > Student should have no backlog of any course at the end of second semester.



#### 2. Fee:

A course fee of Rs.5000/- will be applicable for every course that the student takes as part of the Minor qualification curriculum. Normally a student will be required to study one course every semester thus totaling to five courses from 3rd to  $7^{th}/8^{th}$  semester for the obtaining Minor Qualification. The total fee of the Minor Qualification program will be Rs. 25,000. The fee per semester will be Rs. 5,000. The course fees will have to be paid at the beginning of the every semester along with regular semester fee.

### 3. How to Apply:

Interested students may apply in prescribed online application form (google form) shared on the official E-mail id of the students for enrolling for 'Minor' qualification.

Duly filled-in online application form must be submitted on or before 31st August, 2023.

4. The University has the discretion to not to offer the program in a particular branch due to lack of adequate student interest or academic feasibility.
