GUIDELINES FOR READMISSION OF EX-STUDENT

For NEP 2020 Based Programmes

1. Title and Applicability

These rules shall be called the “Rules for Readmission and Ex-Student Status under NEP 2020” and shall apply to all Certificate, Diploma, Undergraduate, and Postgraduate programmes conducted under the semester system of the University.

2. Definitions

2.1 Readmission

Readmission means permission granted to a student to rejoin the same semester after discontinuation, absence, detention, or non-registration.

2.2 Ex-Student

An Ex-Student is a student who:

- was duly admitted and registered in a programme;
- has been detained or could not appear in the examination due to shortage of attendance;
- did not apply for the examination; or
- applied for the examination but remained absent,
- and is permitted to reappear or continue under the rules of the University.

2.3 Semester Drop

Semester Drop means temporary discontinuation of studies for one or more semesters with prior approval or for valid reasons accepted by the University.

3. Eligibility for Readmission

A student shall be eligible for readmission if:

1. The student has completed registration in the immediately preceding semester.
2. The maximum duration prescribed for completion of the programme has not expired.
3. The student has cleared all dues of the University.
4. The student was not rusticated or expelled on disciplinary grounds.
5. The student applies for readmission within the prescribed time.

4. Readmission in Even/Odd Semester

4.1: A student who appeared in an odd semester but did not appear/register in the corresponding even semester may be permitted readmission in that even semester during the next academic cycle.

4.2: Similarly, a student who discontinued studies in an odd semester may seek readmission in the corresponding odd semester during the next academic cycle.

4.3: Readmission shall ordinarily be allowed under the same semester structure and syllabus applicable to the current batch. However, the total credits earned by the student after readmission shall not be less than the minimum credits prescribed for the current batch/programme.

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5. Ex-Student Permission

Students granted Ex-Student status may be permitted to appear in the End Semester Examination as per university rules and regulations.

6. Promotion Rules

Promotion from one semester to another shall be governed as per the applicable University Regulations, UGC Guidelines, and NEP 2020 provisions as amended from time to time.

7. Maximum Duration

The maximum permissible duration for completion of a programme shall be as prescribed under the applicable University Regulations, UGC Guidelines, and NEP 2020 provisions.

8. Fee for Readmission

Students seeking readmission shall pay:

- Semester tuition fee,
- Examination fee, and
- Prescribed readmission fee.

Late fee may be imposed beyond the notified deadlines.


9. Authority for Approval


The student shall submit the application for readmission to the Student Section at least one month before the commencement of the academic session, duly forwarded by the Dean/Head of the Department.

The readmission shall be approved by the Controller of Examination (CoE) and the Registrar.



10. Interpretation Clause
