states of the country participated, **Best university of Experiential Learning** Award by "The Progress Global Awards 2021-22, **Best Industrial Interface University** Award 2021-22 by Imperial Society of Innovative Engineers (ISIEINDIA) etc., major MoUs signed with leading research and academic institutions, distribution of Entry Level Scholarships, OPJEMS scholarships, faculty growth with significant improvement in Ph.D. qualified faculty.

Admission statistics were also presented, and it was observed that intake quality is also increasing year by year. A comparison of R & D activities of the last 5 years was also presented before the members. The research activities viz. research articles in journals, conference paper, patent publications, incentives provided by the university are also inspiring and appreciated by all the members. The Vice-Chancellor informed all the members that the university has targeted 150 nos. of publications in the current academic year. Placement highlight for the batch 2021-22 and 2022-23 is quite encouraging. Till now 40+ companies conducted campus drives at OPJU. The Highest package offered till now was Rs.10 LPA.

The social activities conducted by the University Social Responsibility (USR) cell in the five adopted villages were also appreciated by the members.

The Member Secretary welcomed all the members to the meeting. With the permission of the Chair, the member secretary started the presentation. The following proceeding were recorded:

1. Minutes of the last meeting were read, and they were confirmed. Member secretary apprised all the members about the latest happening (activities & achievements) at the university viz. successful organization of the 3rd convocation, hosting of 2nd OPJU International Technology Conference on "Emerging Technologies for Sustainable Development" and 3rd International Conference on "Innovation and Research in Science & Technology for Sustainable Development", receipt of various awards and recognitions, such as Ranking in the NIRF Innovation Rankings, placing OPJU in the 150-300 category, Achieving a 3.5 rating in the IIC ranking for 2022, making OPJU one of the top 6 Higher Education Institutions in the central zone, Attaining the 29th position in the Internshala Annual Rankings



for 2023, being honored as The Most Promising Corporate Governed University at the New Normal Education Summit 2023, receiving an "A" Grade with a Gold Band in the OBE ranking for 2023 by World Institutional Ranking. The signing of major Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with prominent research and academic institutions, distribution of Entry Level Scholarships and OPJEMS scholarships, Faculty development, with a notable increase in the number of Ph.D. qualified faculty members

Admission statistics were also presented, in the academic year 2023-24, OPJU achieved a historic milestone by enrolling a record-breaking total of 2040 students with significant improvement in the number of female students. A comparison of R & D activities of the last 3 years was also presented before the members. The research activities viz. research articles in journals, conference papers, patent publications, and incentives provided by the university are also inspiring and appreciated by all the members. The placement outcomes for the batch of 2022-23 at OPJU are highly promising. Over 120 companies have conducted campus recruitment drives, with the highest offered package reaching Rs. 16 LPA. The overall placement rate for the academic year 2022-23 stood at an impressive 95%.

The social activities conducted by the University Social Responsibility (USR) cell in the five adopted villages were also appreciated by the members.


After thorough discussions, all the members unanimously accorded their approval to the following proposals:

- Four years NEP based ordinances with the scope of Multi exit and entry options for courses like BBA, B.Com., BA (Economics), B.Sc. and B. P. Ed. along with other ordinances like Certificate Courses, Diploma Courses and PG Diploma courses under the School of Physical Education.
- Introduction of new subjects (Indian Knowledge System) and syllabus of B.Sc.(Hons)- Data Science and Analytics, B.Sc. (Hons.)- Biotechnology, B.Sc. (Hons.) GE courses and Core courses.
- Revision of Schemes and Syllabus in Metallurgical (B. Tech and M. Tech), Civil (B. Tech), Computer Science & Engineering (B. Tech & M. Tech) and Mechanical Engineering (B. Tech), Electrical Engineering (B. Tech and M. Tech.)



- Revision of Schemes and Syllabus in MBA, EMBA, BBA, and B.Com (Hons.)
- Amendment in the bridge courses for B. Tech (Lateral Entry).
